As the Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff G-3/5/7, he is responsible for planning and overseeing the daily operations of the TRADOC institutional training base including developing and implementing plans to expand/mobilize the training base in support of joint warfighting commanders through Army Force Generation (ARFORGEN). Mr. Formica oversees Joint and Collective training initiatives and CONUS/OCONUS Security Assistance training. He also serves as the Functional Chief's Representative for Civilian Career Program-32 (Training, Capabilities, and Doctrine Warfighting Developers).
